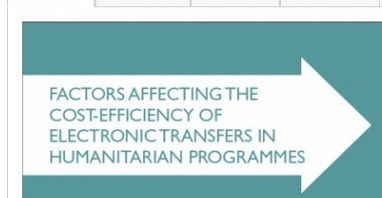

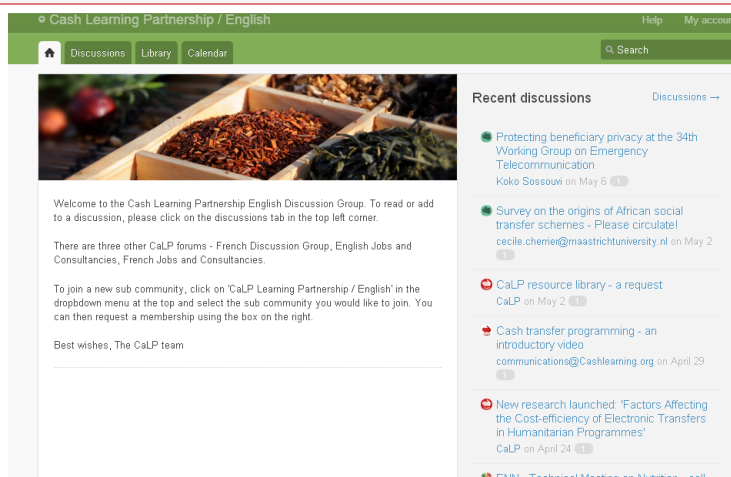

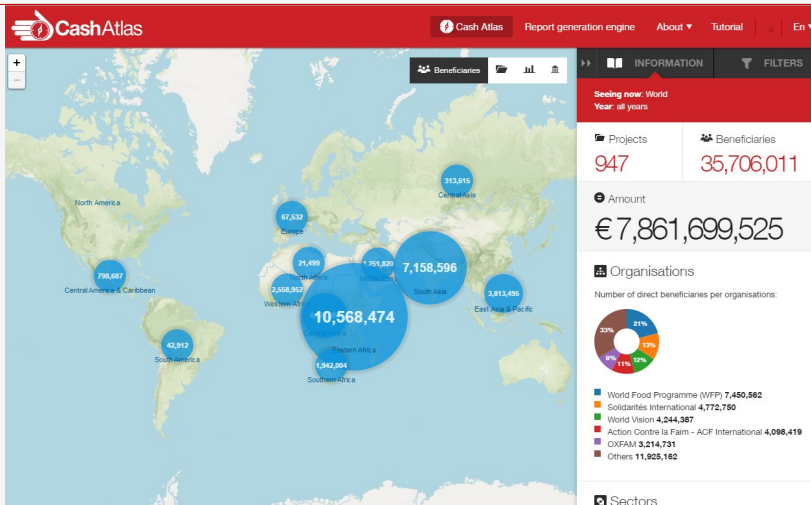


D-group (<http://dgroups.org/groups/CaLP>)
