Standard Courses	
CVA - THE FUNDAMENTALS (EN, FR, AR, SP)	I-day: This course targets any staff who are new to CVA, and is designed as an introduction to key concepts, definitions and myths relating to cash and voucher assistance in humanitarian settings.
CORE CVA SKILLS FOR PROGRAMME STAFF (EN, FR, SP)	5-days: For programme staff responsible for designing, implementing and monitoring cash and voucher assistance.
CORE CVA SKILLS FOR MANAGERS (EN)	2-days: Designed for managers with the aim to equip participants to integrate CVA into strategic programme management and coordination.
CORE CVA SKILLS FOR SUP- PLY CHAIN, FINANCE AND ICT STAFF (EN)	5-days: Ensures understanding of modalities and mechanisms for delivery and its implications to operations.
Specialised Courses	
SOCIAL PROTECTION AND CVA TRAINING MATERIALS (EN, FR)	0.5/1-day: A 2-part course building knowledge of key steps and considerations involved in designing humanitarian assistance that contribute to strengthening/ developing social protection systems in the country
PROTECTION IN CASH-BASED INTERVENTIONS (EN)	I-day: Familiarizes humanitarian agency staff with the Guide for Protection and Cash-Based Interventions and key resources.
CASH AND VOUCHER ASSISTANCE & LIVELIHOODS (EN)	0.5-days: Develops understanding of the basic concepts of livelihoods programming including terminology, and the importance of CVA as a tool to achieve livelihoods objectives.
MARKET ASSESSMENT TOOLS TRAINING (EN, FR)	3.5(without field school)/5(with f/s)-days: The focus of the course is to measure market performance and how to select appropriate market tools and guidance.
RESPONSE ANALYSIS AND CVA (EN, FR)	3-days: This course provides classroom-based training, grounded in project experiences and practical exercises, and is designed to build advanced knowledge and technical expertise in response analysis processes.
MONITORING 4 CVA (EN, FR)	I-day: Develops the knowledge, skills and confidence of field-based practitioners to support and undertake monitoring of humanitarian cash and voucher programmes.
