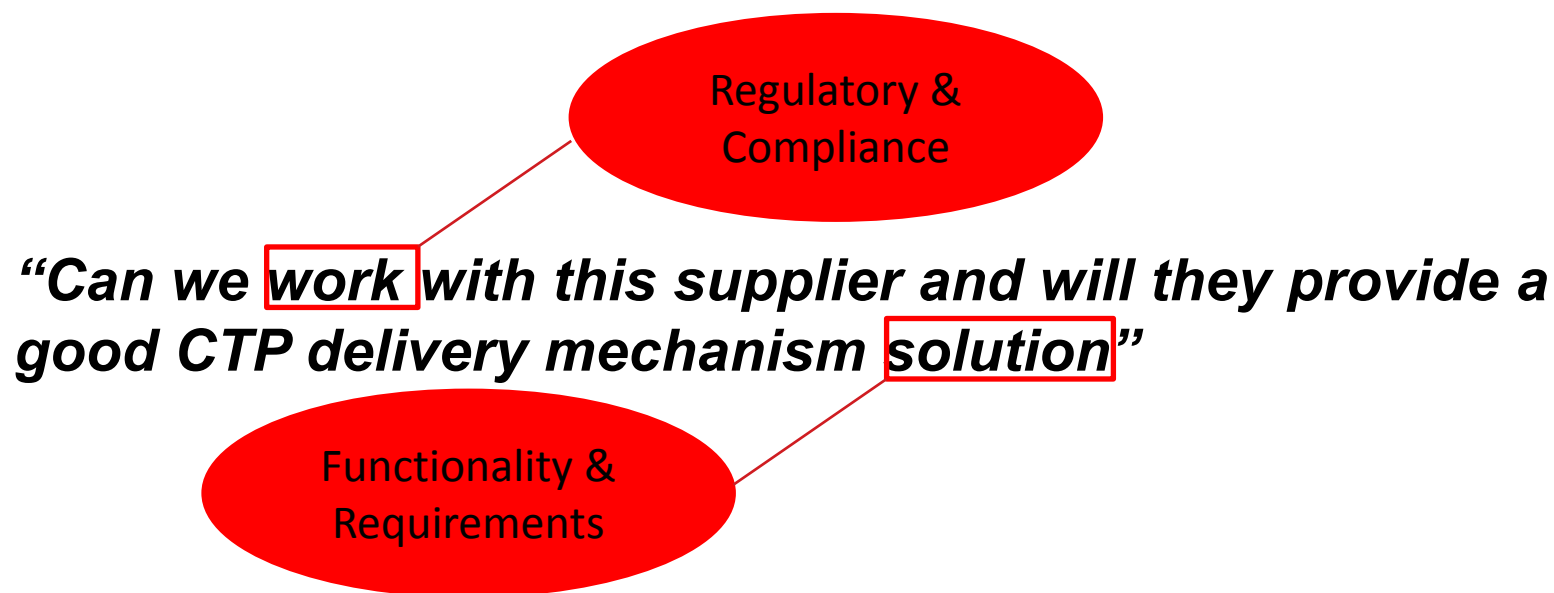
## *The Current Situation (as I see it!)*

## *The problem statement*

Currently we are struggling objectively, confidently and quickly to evaluate:



## ***Examples:***

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- What **information** is required by stakeholders?
- What **additional steps** might be requested?
- What is **mandatory** and what are the **timelines**?
- Who is **responsible** for outlining/obtaining what info
- What constitutes a “**change**” from **agreed standards**?
- What info is for “**best practice**” or what is to make us **feel comfortable** in this new world?

## *In Summary*

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- What is best practice and most helpful for decision making at each procurement threshold?
- What is reasonable to ask for?

With the aim of identifying;

**WHAT INFORMATION AND IN WHAT FORMAT WILL  
ACTUALLY HELP US IN THE DECISION MAKING FOR FSP &  
SOLUTION EVALUATION?**

- Against requirements of the tender
- Against the other FSPs responding to the tender

## ***Other issues***

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- **Single Delivery Platform** – using another agencies delivery mechanism how to we ensure: (a) we mitigate risks related to funds transferred as well as meeting regulatory and compliance; (b) we meet the procurement rules/regulations and Donor Compliance (c) reporting
- **Innovation/piloting** – how can we quickly and easily pilot a delivery mechanism (in a limited and controlled manner) to test requirements, advocate for /demonstrate CTP without breaching procurement rules and donor compliance.
