





Added Value of Cash Preparedness


- Cash for relief can be achieved with the right preparedness.
- Scale is possible without compromising accountability or quality.
- Preparedness builds confidence and institutionalises the use of cash
- National Societies have an auxiliary role to government and are strategically important for advocacy and sustainability.



Cash Preparedness

CTP Preparedness: Priorities of the CPWG

- Review trends, good practice, lessons learnt and link to other organizations active in CTP.
- Support the IFRC Secretariat in raising issues and preparing papers (e.g. DMWG)
- Link with all sectors involved in emergency response to advocate and build capacity and awareness of CTP
- Develop a profile and competency framework for CTP, standardise JDs, develop an IFRC practical training for emergency response personnel, build network of cash specialists.
- Develop a common framework for building preparedness capacity for CTP relief in National Societies and resource and utilise the framework to build capacity in the most hazard prone countries.
- Explore, test and agree global and regional agreements with cash delivery providers where feasible and possible.
- To support the development of a CTP community of practice / network
