The guidance includes four review grids, three sample tools, two question banks and a checklist. Together these lay out step-by step instructions for adapting a range of your organisation’s food security data collection tools and processes.

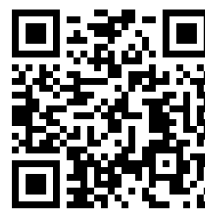
